Hybrid Provider Course: 16-hour course (8 hours online, 9 hours in-person) for EMTs, paramedics, nurses, physician assistants, physicians and other prehospital providers. Upon successful completion of the course, students receive a certificate of completion, a wallet card recognizing them as PHTLS providers for 4 years, and 16 hours of CAPCE credit.

This class is supported by a grant from the ODOT/DMV Traffic Safety Office to strengthen the care provided by rural emergency responders to vehicle crash victims on Oregon roadways; reduce vehicle crash scene times; & support the EMS work force by acquiring CE that is applicable to maintain their EMS licenses!#Qualifications for attending grant-funded classes are explained at the course registration page. #
